50 Foot Rule: No Wake within 50 Foot
of Docks, Boats, and People



Water Ski Safely with Life Jacket and
Not Before Sunrise or After Sunset



Practice Safe Boating: No Reckless
Operation, Obey Buoys, Use Lights after Dark
and Slow Down



Jet Skis: Look over Shoulder before
Turning; No Steering without Throttle. Not
Before Sunrise or After Sunset

Have Boat Registration/Numbers



Don't Make a Splash with
Trash

Use Common Sense & Courtesy.

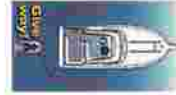


Be Aware of Surroundings and Respect Property.

Navigation Rules



Stay to the Right. The Port (left) Vessel gives Way.



Overtaking Vessel Gives Way

50 Foot Rule



You Must Reduce Speed to **NO WAKE (idle speed)**
when within 50 feet of:

- Docks, piers or boathouses
- Boat Ramps
- Persons in the Water
- Other Boats

PWC—Jet Ski



- You must be 16 or 14 and Pass Boater Safety Class
- Wear Life Jacket
- Do not Operate After Sunset/Before Dawn
